



Race Weekend Instructions



Thank You for registering for the Surfer's Path 10k & 5k. We're excited to bring you this event that showcases the beautiful Santa Cruz County coast. Following is helpful race weekend information:

PACKET PICK-UP & REGISTRATION

Friday, February 21, 2020

NEW LOCATION: Road Runner Sports, 877 East Hamilton Ave, Campbell

HOURS: 5:00PM - 8:00PM

Saturday, February 22, 2020

LOCATION: Nob Hill Foods, 809 Bay Ave, Capitola

HOURS: 10:00AM - 4:00PM

Sunday, February 23, 2020

Registration and packet pick-up will be available race morning near the start line located at 816 41st Ave Santa Cruz for those who absolutely can't pick up their race bib/chip on Friday or Saturday. We strongly encourage participants to pick up their race materials prior to race morning. There will be an additional **\$10 fee** for bibs picked up race morning.

SURFER'S PATH 10K/5K

SUNDAY, February 23, 2020

START LOCATION: On 41st Ave at 816 41st Ave, Santa Cruz

START TIMES: 8:00am- 10k, 8:10am- 5k

RACE DAY PARKING

The Surfer's Path 10k/5k courses are designed to maximize coastal views and offer optimal turn around locations. To accomplish this, the start and finish areas are set in two locations, less than a mile apart. We recommend parking mid-way between the start and finish and enjoy a short pre-event warm up and post event cool down. There is plenty of free, on-street parking between the Start and Finish.

If you are planning to be dropped off near the start line, drivers can continue to Capitola Village parking lots above Capitola Village and the Finish. Access to Beach and Village Parking Lots 1 & 2 (Upper and Lower) is on Capitola Avenue, Bay Avenue and Monterey Avenue. Parking costs for these lots is \$0.50 per hour and you can pay for up to 12 hours.

There is NO PARKING in business lots located along 41st Ave between Melton Street and Court Drive, and on Portola Drive, between 36th Ave and Adriene Way. Vehicles will be subject to posting parking restrictions at these locations.

SWEAT CHECK

There will be a sweat check area near the start line on 41st Ave courtesy of Kennolyn Camps. Checked bags will be available for pick up near the finish line.



AID STATIONS

There will be three course aid stations for the 10k, at approximately miles 1.7, 3.5 and 4.3. There will be one course aid station for the 5k at approximately mile 1.9.

SANITARY FACILITIES

There will be sanitary facilities at the start, near each aid station and at the finish.

COURSE MANAGEMENT

The course is managed at a 20:00 minute per mile pace. Course materials are picked up on a mile by mile rolling basis. If you are unable to run/walk within the allotted time, you will be asked to move onto the sidewalk. Once you are on the sidewalk, you must follow all traffic laws deemed by the County of Santa Cruz and City of Capitola. The course will be re-opened to traffic.

FINISH LINE

The finish line is located at the corner of Esplanade and San Jose Ave, at 203 Esplanade in Capitola Village.

MEDALS & SHIRTS

All participants will receive a commemorative finisher medal after crossing the finish line. Event shirts will be available after the finish near the Capitola Bandstand.

AWARDS

Awards will be provided to the top three over-all finishers in each event. The awards will take place for the 5k & 10k near the Capitola Bandstand at approximately 9:00am.

POST RACE FOOD

There will be a variety of post race refreshments located near the Capitola Bandstand courtesy of Nob Hill Foods.
